


Online Resources for Speech-Language Therapy

Hello speech and language families!! I hope everyone is doing well and is staying healthy at home. This past week, many students started virtual learning or received packets from their teachers for at home learning. Hopefully, everyone has had a chance to look those over and are ready to dive into some speech-language skills next!

I have created videos that work on a variety of speech and language tasks (steps on how to access these videos are on the next page). I ask that both parents and the student watch the introduction video together. It gives guidance on how often to practice. If it is difficult to find the time for practice, the video also explains other ways to use classroom work with speech and language goals. There is also a video for building routines during this time away from school, but that is an optional video.

When selecting videos, students who are working on speech sounds should select a video from the topic: **Articulation: Speech Sounds**. Students who work on social communication skills will pick videos from: **Social Language**. Students who are working on grammar, answering wh-questions, and following directions should choose videos from: **Grammar** or **Miscellaneous Language Skills**. Students with fluency goals, will want to check out the **Fluency** videos. Finally, students who are in Bright Beginnings, Playgroup, or attend only speech therapy and are 3 and 4 years-old, will want to check out videos under the following topics: **Early Language** and **Playgroup**. There is a guest appearance from Mrs. Schommer with reading some fun books!!




