Kowalski: Reports that they have almost wrapped up the Wisconsin Forward Exams, which takes about two weeks to complete. Everyone is glad to be done. Summer school is being planned for and the course booklet is being made. They have activities like the Safety Camp put on by Mayo, then ATV, Snowmobile, Boating and Hunting courses that are DNR certified. That should be coming out the second Monday of May. This year there is a new way to sign up through an online system. Long Term Substitute Teachers are "doing a great job and jumping in with two feet."

Dommer states that they continue to work with the food shelf and provide weekend meals for 75-80 children weekly. They will be accepting applications for next years' 5th grade students who want to be part of the Safety Patrol. Dommer said that this year's safety patrol participants will be given a party to thank them for their hard work this school year. Tonight is the Spring Concert and everyone is excited! He states that Miss Neby does a great job and they are the "best (performances) I've ever seen."

Nelson: State testing ends Friday and he is proud of the effort and support the students showed. They are talking about doing a Summer School Credit Recovery Option for students. It will focus on core courses from 8:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. and will go longer than summer school for elementary students. The program will be online through Add Momentum. Career Day was today. Students were engaged and well behaved. 6th graders went to Cardinal Glass, 7th graders went to CVTC, and 8th graders went to UW-Eau Claire in the morning. HS students were able to choose where they wanted to go and had a number of opportunities to choose from. In the afternoon over 50 members of the community spoke to groups of

students about their career and how they got to where they are today. Mrs. Widiker, Mr. Morehead, Mrs. Volker, and Matt Forrest headed up Career Day and Nelson was "very pleased" with how it all worked out and the student behavior. Wednesday, May 1, 2024 is Give Back Day.
